Demurrage charge of \$2 for each day that it remains unclaimed after the expiration of that period, with a minimum charge of \$16. (If parcels from overseas are not collected within two months from the posting of a notification of arrival, it may be returned to the sender or otherwise disposed of as the Postmaster General thinks fit. Local parcels remaining uncollected for 14 days after the date of a notification of arrival will be returned to the sender.)
